

Roanoke City Electoral Board Meeting Minutes Thursday June 15th, 2017

Meeting called to order at 2:06PM

In attendance: Electoral Board members Sharon Lazar, Byron Hamlar, and John Brill; and Registrar Andrew Cochran.

- Continued ballot inventory
- The Board continued the Ballot inventory, examining the irregularities of Precincts 10 Old Southwest-Wasena, 12 South Roanoke, and 20 Forest Park
 - 10 Old Southwest Wasena should have received three packages of Republican ballots. The Ballot Record Report shows 200 Republican Ballots. The Board did a weight comparison of the box containing unopened packages and another package that contained 300 ballots and is satisfied that the EDO's miscounted their packages. The Ballot Record Report for Democrat primary adds up.
 - 12 South Roanoke should have received four packages of Democrat ballots and four packages of Republican ballots, and so should have had 400 Democrat ballots and 400 Republican ballots. The Ballot Record Report shows 421 Democrat Ballots and 402 Republican Ballots. The Board theorizes that unused ballots were miscounted.
 - 20 Forest Park should have should have received two packages of Republican ballots. The Ballot Record Report shows 211 Republican Ballots. The Board theorizes that unused ballots were miscounted. The Ballot Record Report for Democrat primary adds up.
- The Board agreed to have Mr. Cochran ask the State Board of Elections permission to open the boxes for precincts 12 and 20 so as to verify the number of ballots.
- The board agreed to meet next on Thursday, July 6th at 2PM
- Discussion of training in Richmond on June 20th-22nd
