Teaching Artist Sought for Artist-in-Residence Program at Carilion Clinic

Deadline Extended to July 14, 2018

The Dr. Robert L. A. Keeley Healing Arts Program at Carilion Clinic, an initiative of Carilion Foundation, is looking for a teaching artist who is skilled in sharing creativity with others to provide bedside experiences for patients, demonstrations in public spaces, and occasional workshops for staff. The primary purpose of the Artist-in-Residence role is to promote holistic healing by inspiring creativity, uplifting spirits, and facilitating human connection. Visual, performing, and literary artists are encouraged to apply. **A stipend of \$7,500 will be provided as well as orientation and supplies.** Time commitment is **8 hours weekly over a 9 month period.** Hours must be worked between 8am and 5pm Monday through Friday.
