

How to Place a Hold

- 1. Visit www.rvl.info from your computer, phone, or tablet.**
- 2. Click the Log In link at the top of the page.**
- 3. Type in your library card number and pin.
Use RVL if you have not created a personalized pin**
- 4. Use the search bar to explore our catalog for books, movies, music, and audiobooks. You can search by keyword, title, author, and much more.**
- 5. Once you find something you'd like to place on hold, select the Place Hold button to the right of the item.**
- 6. Choose which library you want to visit in order to pick up your item and select Place Hold.**
- 7. When your items are ready, we will call you to coordinate a curbside pick up!**
