### Application for Disabled Veteran Personal Property Tax Relief

Effective January 1, 2021, Code of Virginia §58.1-3668 allows one motor vehicle owned and regularly used by a disabled veteran to be exempt from personal property taxes. Motor vehicle means only passenger car or a pickup or panel truck that is registered for personal use.

To qualify, the veteran must be certified by Veterans Affairs to be 100% totally and permanently disabled. Please submit the following document to determine your eligibility:

\*This exemption shall be applicable beginning on the date the motor vehicle is acquired or January 1, 2021, whichever is later, and shall not be applicable for any period of time prior to January 1, 2021. The exemption shall expire on the date of the disabled veteran's death and shall not be available for the surviving spouse.
